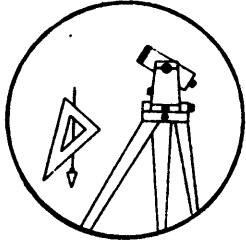
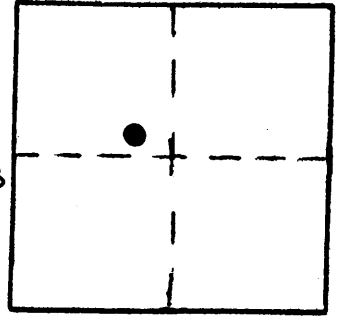

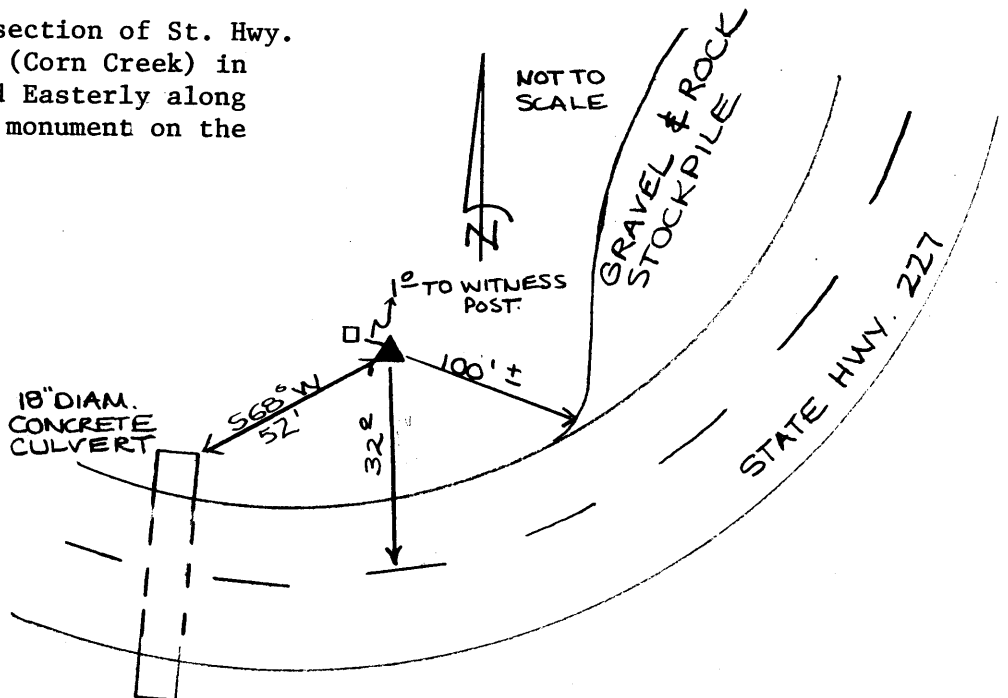

Found: A standard USC&GS disk stamped "L 500 1949" set in a 12" diam. concrete post 6" above the ground.
