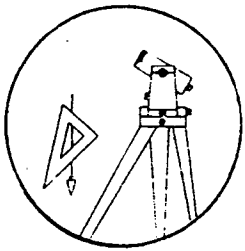
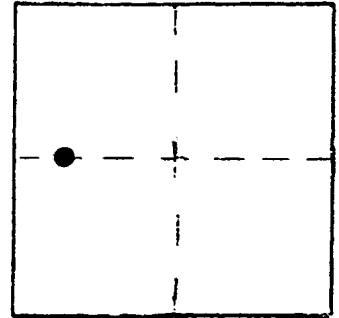

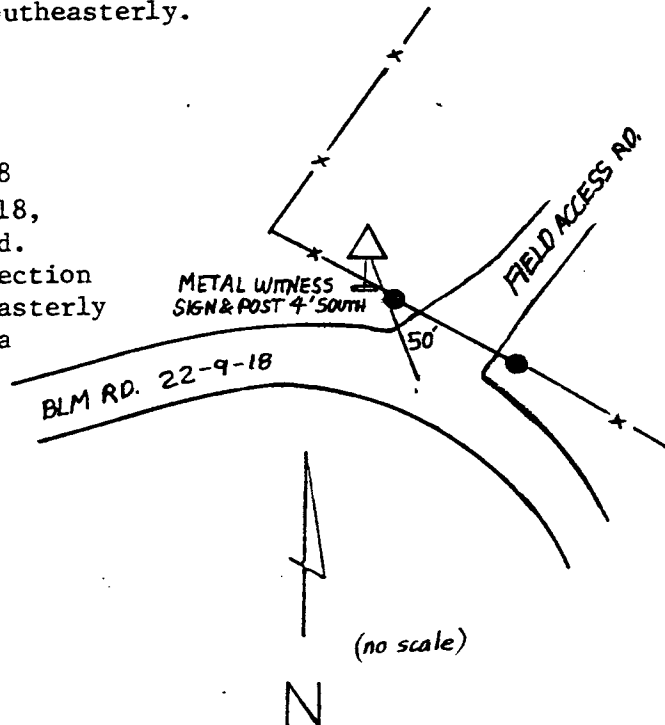
DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

SKETCH

A DCSO disk stamped "LUTS-11 1988" set in a 1x2 foot boulder protruding 1 foot from ground on east side and against a field fence running northwesterly and southeasterly.

TO REACH:

From the intersection of State Highway 38 and Lutsinger Creek Rd. in T22S,R9W,Sec.18, proceed easterly along Lutsinger Creek Rd. approximately 7.35 miles to a "Y" intersection in T22S,R9W,Sec.13, proceed along northeasterly fork of road approximately 1.0 miles to a gated field access road and monument on left.
