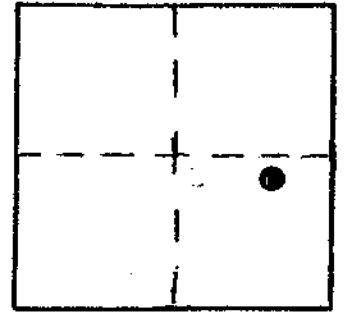

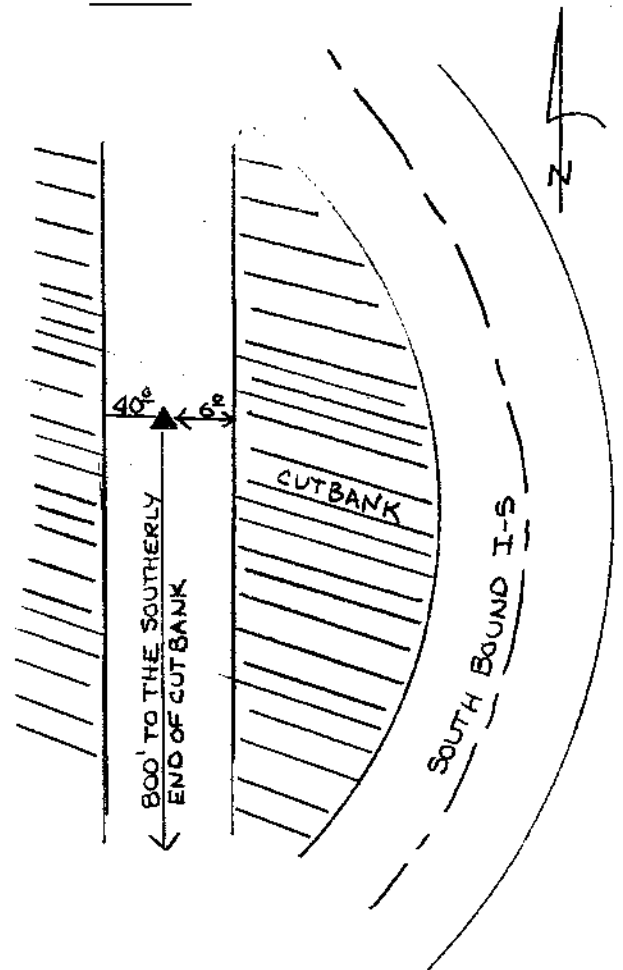

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

Found: A standard DCSO disk set in 6" concrete filled tile 4" above the ground stamped "PTS-11 1975". Witness sign and post bear S 33° W, 3.4ft.

To reach: From the intersection of Co. Rd. #36 (Azalea overpass) and north bound I-5 ramp, proceed northerly 0.6 miles to station on west side of I-5 and on first terrace of cut bank.
