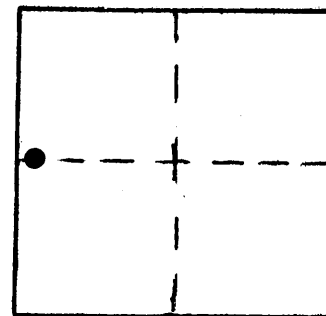

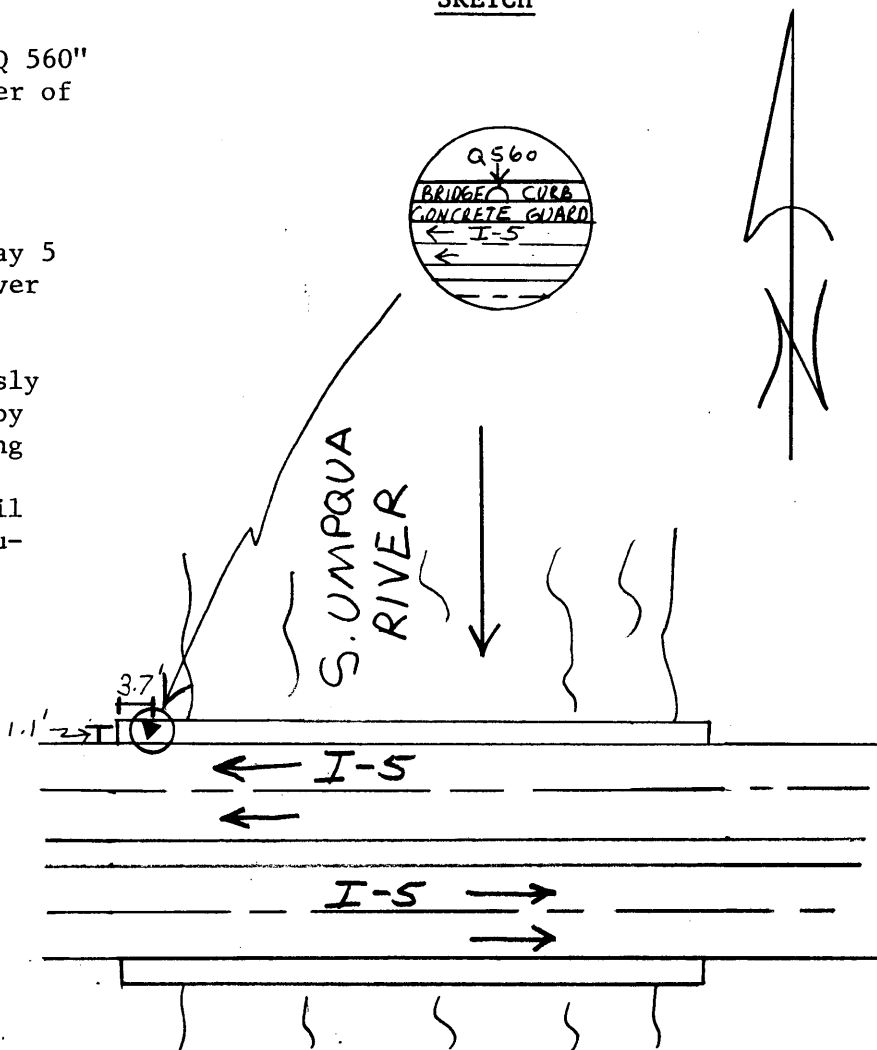
SKETCH

An O.S.H.D. disk stamped "Q 560" set flush in the northwest corner of bridge curb.

TO REACH:

Go to the Interstate Highway 5 bridge over the South Umpqua River in T30S,R5W,Sec. 20.

*NOTE: Station was previously thought to have been destroyed by bridge construction work. Setting up on monument may be difficult because of new concrete guardrail that covers up about 2/5 of monument disk.
