DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

SKETCH

Station is a standard USC&GS disk stamped "R 499 1949", and set in a concrete post with witness post and sign on southerly side of monument. Disk is flush with ground.

To Reach: From the intersection of Co. Rd. 35 and Co. Rd. 35A in S.22 T30S, R5W, proceed easterly 0.9 mi. along Co. Rd. 35 to its intersection with Morgan Creek Rd.. Continue easterly on Co. Rd. 35 2.0 mi. to the end of Co. Rd. 35.
