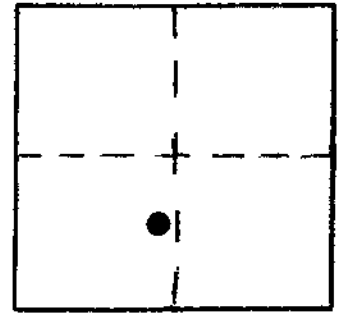

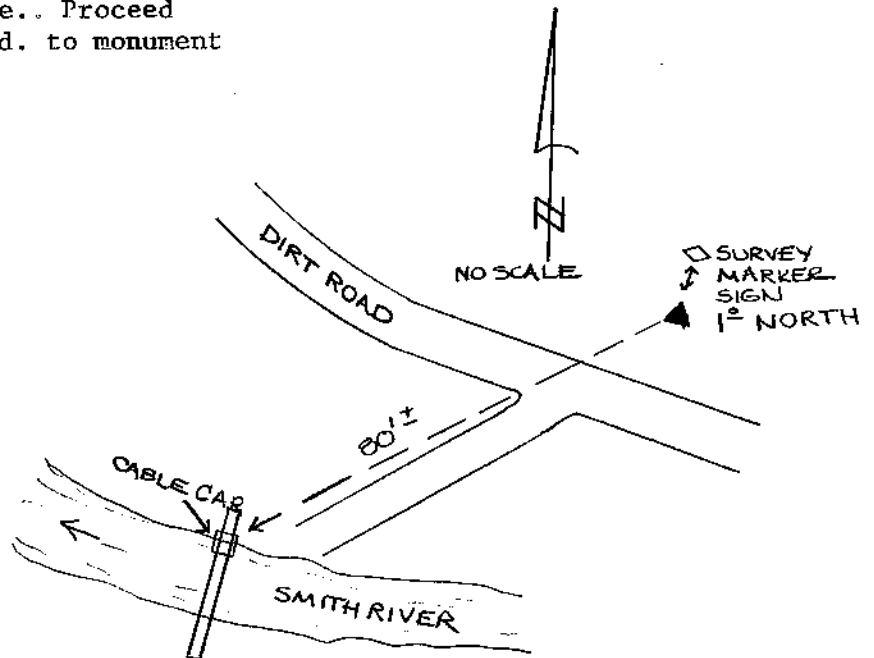

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

SKETCH

Found: A standard DCSO disk set in concrete tile protruding 2" above the ground stamped "S-16 1973".

To reach: From the intersection of Co. Rd. #48A & 48 (in sec. 31 T20S R10W) proceed Easterly along Rd. #48 1.45 miles to a private gravel Rd. on the right (in sec. 32 T20S R10W) proceed southerly along private Rd. 0.95 miles to a locked International Paper gate.. Proceed thru gate 1.5 miles along private Rd. to monument on the right.
