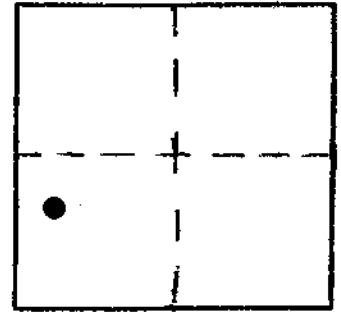

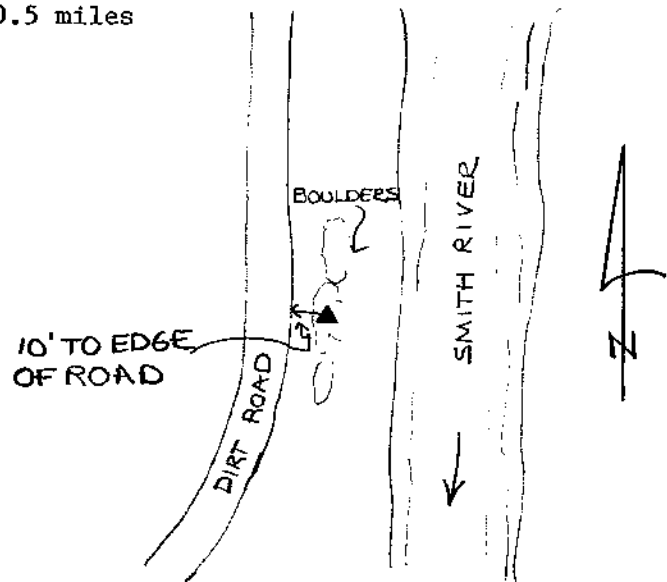

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

SKETCH

Found: A standard DCSO disk set in large boulder flush with ground stamped " S-17 1973". Survey marker sign alongside.

To reach: From the intersection of Co. Rd. #48A & Rd. #48 ( in sec 31 T20S R10W) proceed easterly along Rd. #48 1.45 miles to a private gravel road on the right (in sec 32 T20S R10W), proceed southerly along private road 0.95 miles to a locked International Paper Co. gate. Proceed thru gate 0.5 miles along private road to monument on the left.
