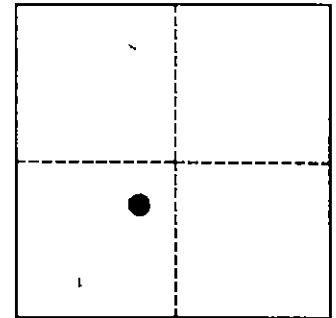
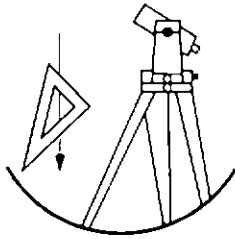

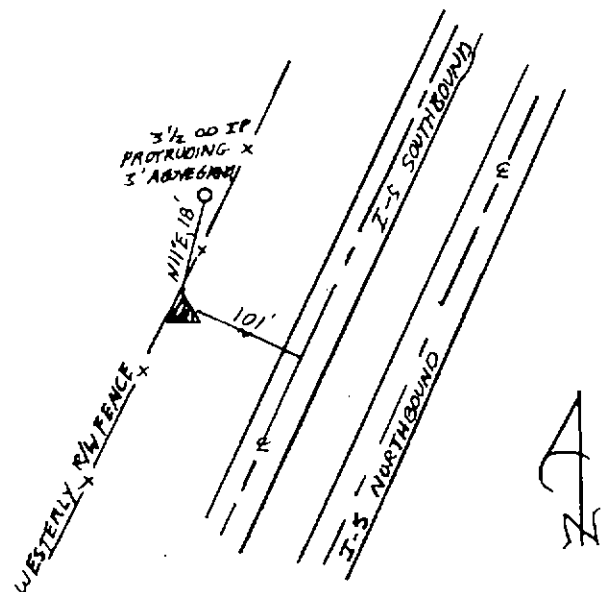

Found: A 9/16 inch diameter stainless steel rod set under a 6 - 5/8 inch diameter aluminum collar and access cover set flush with ground in concrete. The rim of the access cover collar is stamped "T 739 1987".

To reach: From the Rice Valley Rd. (Co. Rd. #30) overcrossing of Interstate Highway 5, at I-5 exit #146, proceed southerly along I-5 approx. 3.8 miles to mile point 142.5 and monument on right against westerly R/W fence. Monument is also 0.35 miles north from Metz Hill Rd. (Co. Rd. #74) overcrossing of Interstate Highway 5 at exit #142.
