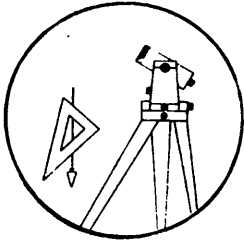
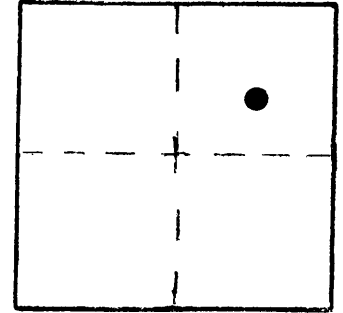

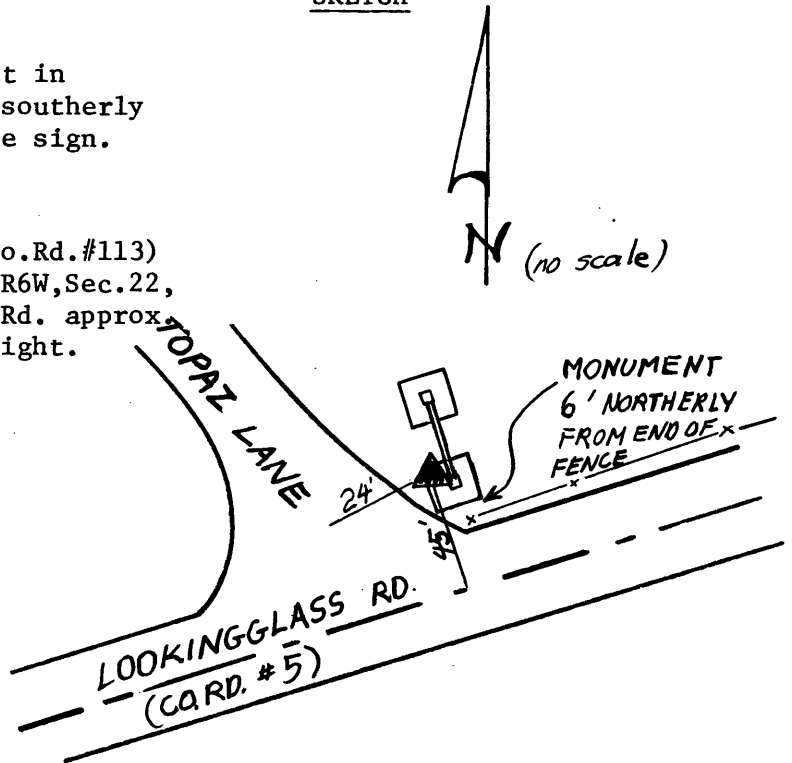

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

SKETCH

A DCSO drill cap stamped "VALLEY 1989" set in a 4 ft. by 4 ft. concrete pad supporting southerly end of Diamond Valley subdivision entrance sign.

From the intersection of Military ave. (Co.Rd.#113) and Lookingglass Rd. (Co.Rd.#5D) in T27S,R6W,Sec.22, proceed southwesterly along Lookingglass Rd. approx. 0.9 miles to Topaz lane and monument on right.
