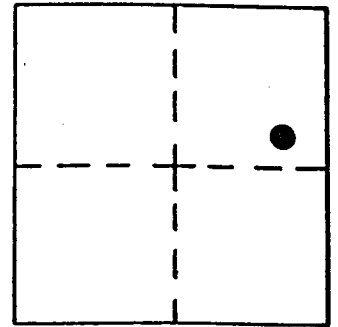
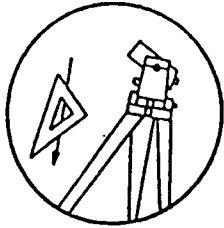

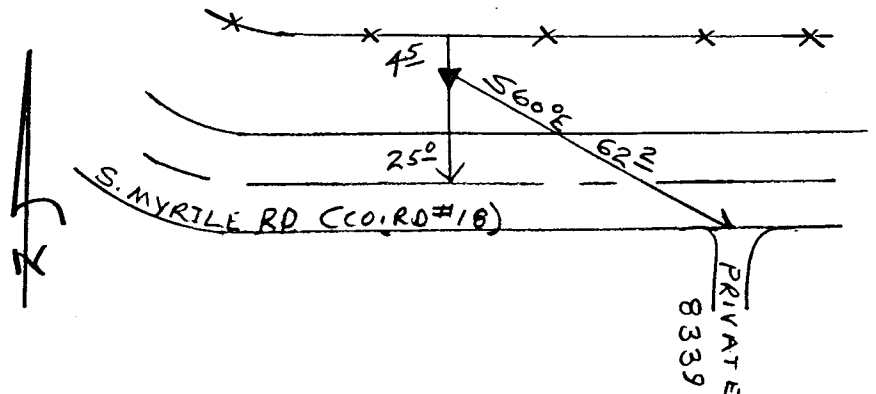

Set: A standard DCSO disk stamped "X-044 1992" set in a 6" x 36" corrugated sewer pipe protruding 3" from the ground and filled with concrete.

To reach: From the intersection of South Myrtle Rd. (Co.Rd.#18) and Riverside Dr. (Co.Rd.#18A) in T29S R5W sec. 23, continue on South Myrtle Rd. to MP 7.95 and mon. on the left. Also from the intersection of South Myrtle Rd. and Ben Branch Rd. continue on South Myrtle Rd. 0.2mi easterly to monument on the left.
