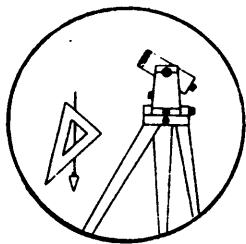

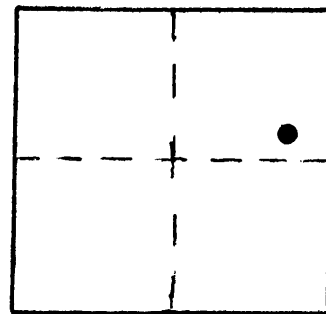

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

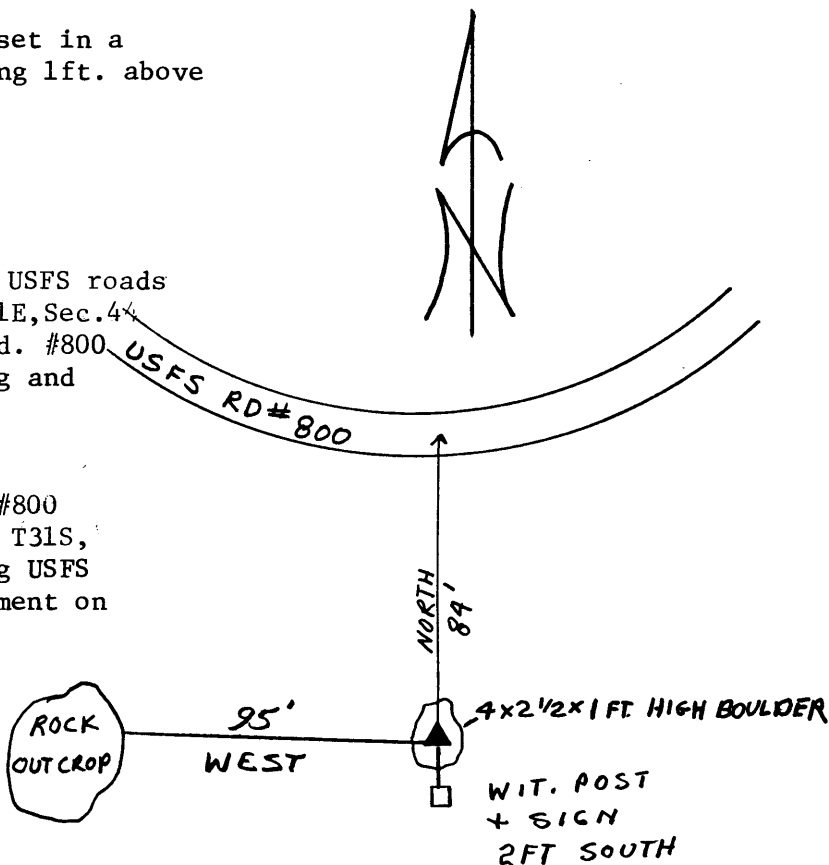
SKETCH

A USC&GS disk stamped "Y501 1949" set in a 4 ft. X 2 1/2 ft. boulder protruding 1ft. above ground.

TO REACH:

From the four-way intersection of USFS roads #2925, #600, #700 and #800 in T31S, R1E, Sec. 44, proceed southeasterly along USFS Rd. #800 approx. 2.1 miles to small clearing and monument on right.

From the intersection of USFS Rd. #800 and #810 (road to Butler Butte) in T31S, R1E, Sec. 10, proceed westerly along USFS Rd. #800 approx. 0.2 miles to monument on left.
