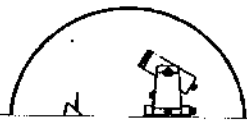
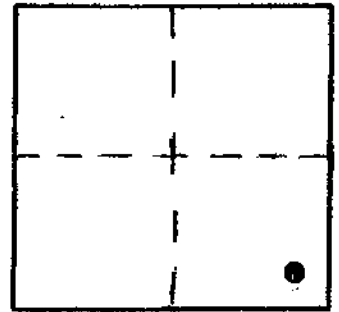

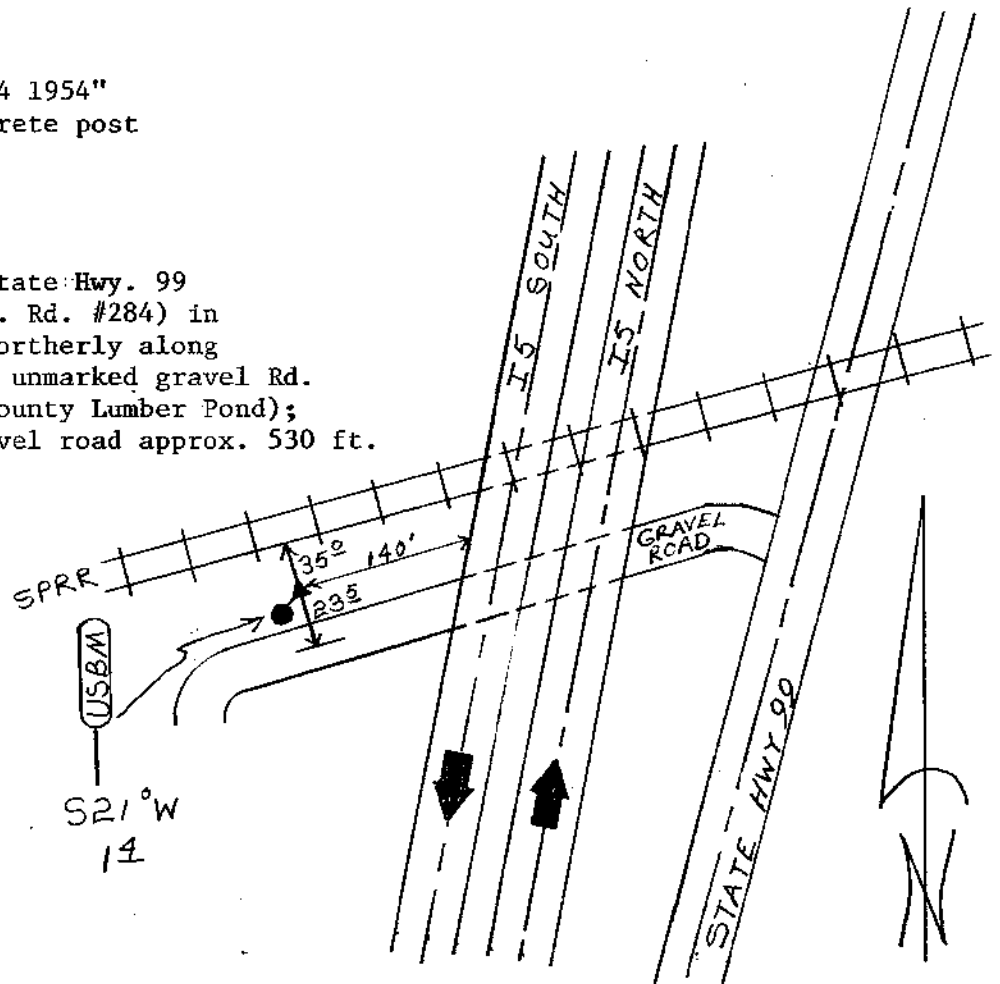

and Umpqua College Rd. (Co. Rd. #284) in
T26S,R6W,Sec. 24, proceed northerly along
State Hwy. 99 1.0 miles to unmarked gravel Rd.
on left (road to Douglas County Lumber Pond);
proceed westerly along gravel road approx. 530 ft.
to monument on right.
