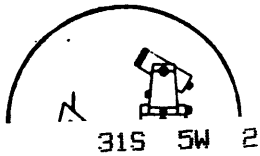
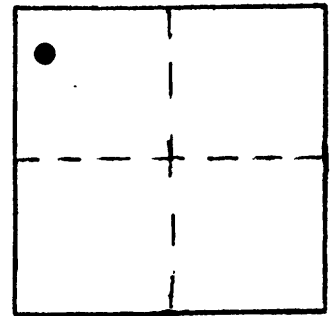

DESCRIPTION:

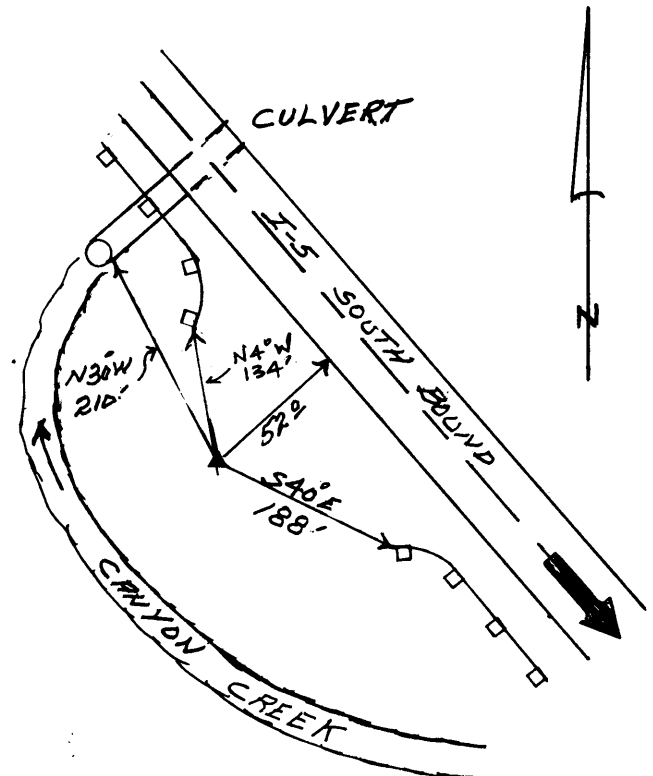
A DCSO disk stamped "PTS-20 1975"
