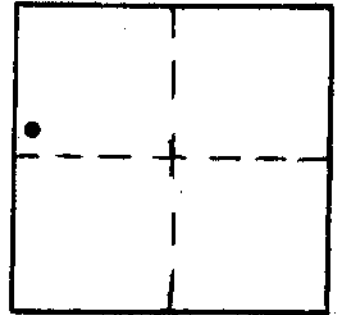

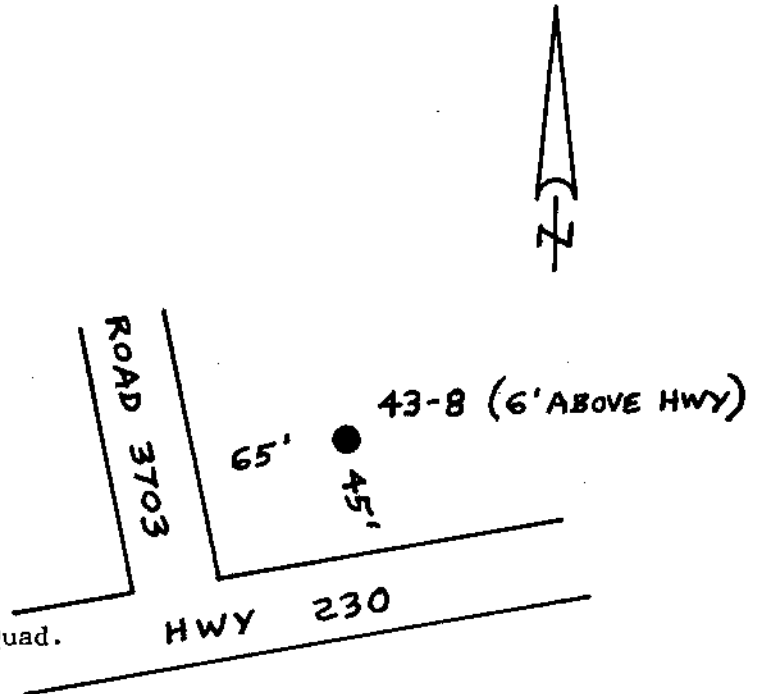
NE of intersection of Highway
