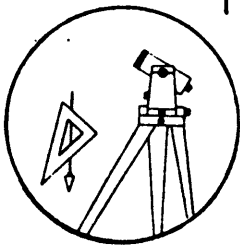
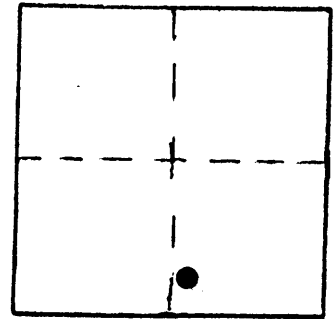

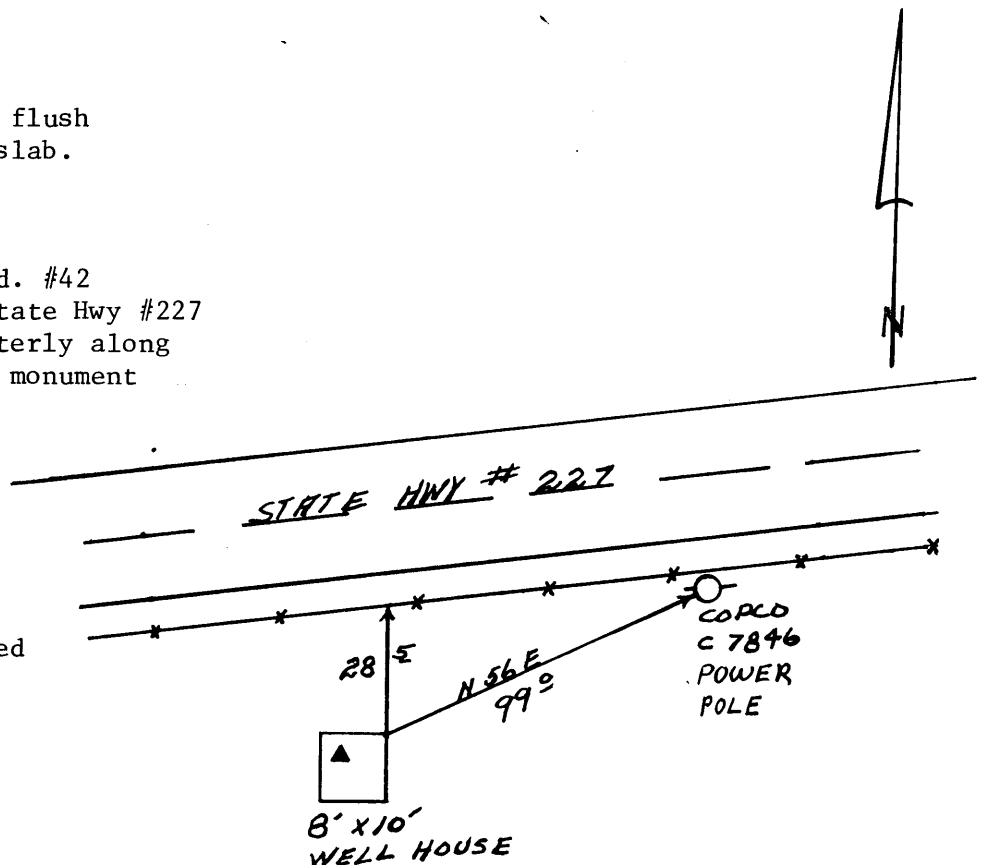
A disk stamped "T499 1949" set flush

State Hwy. #227 0.15 miles to monument
on left.
