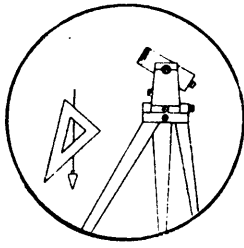
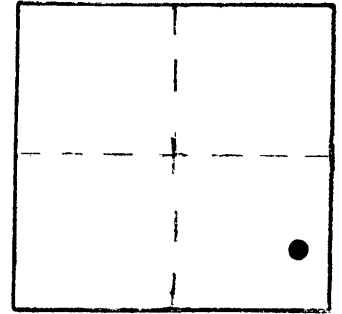

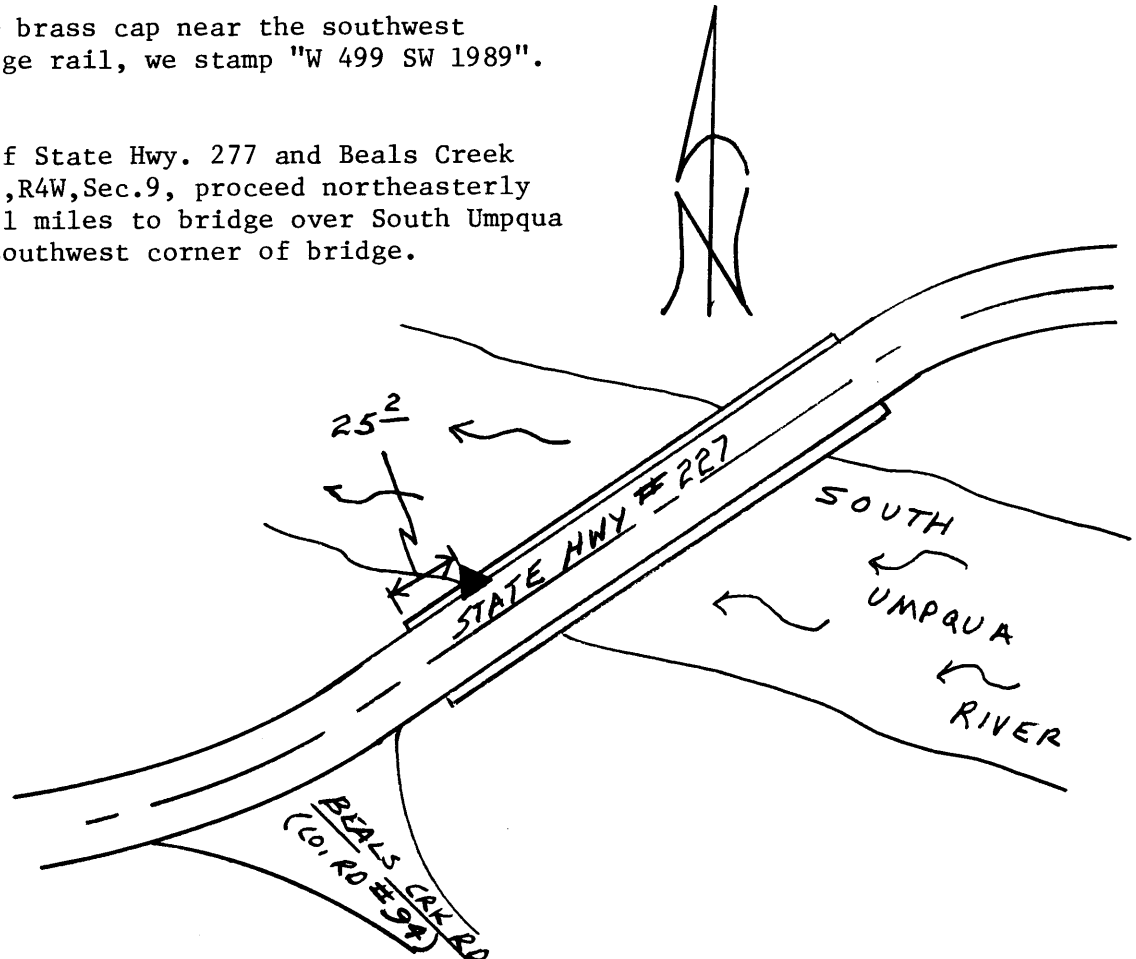

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

SKETCH

Found an unstamped DCED brass cap near the southwest corner of concrete bridge rail, we stamp "W 499 SW 1989".

From the intersection of State Hwy. 277 and Beals Creek Rd. (Co.Rd.#94) in T30S,R4W,Sec.9, proceed northeasterly along State Hwy. 277 0.1 miles to bridge over South Umpqua river. Monument is at southwest corner of bridge.
