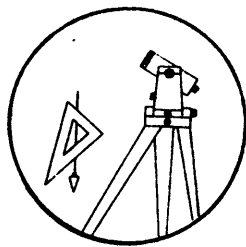
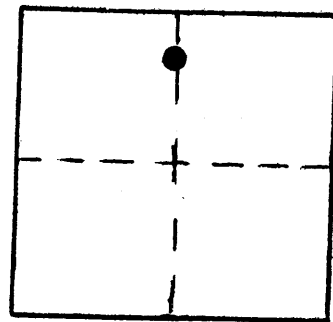

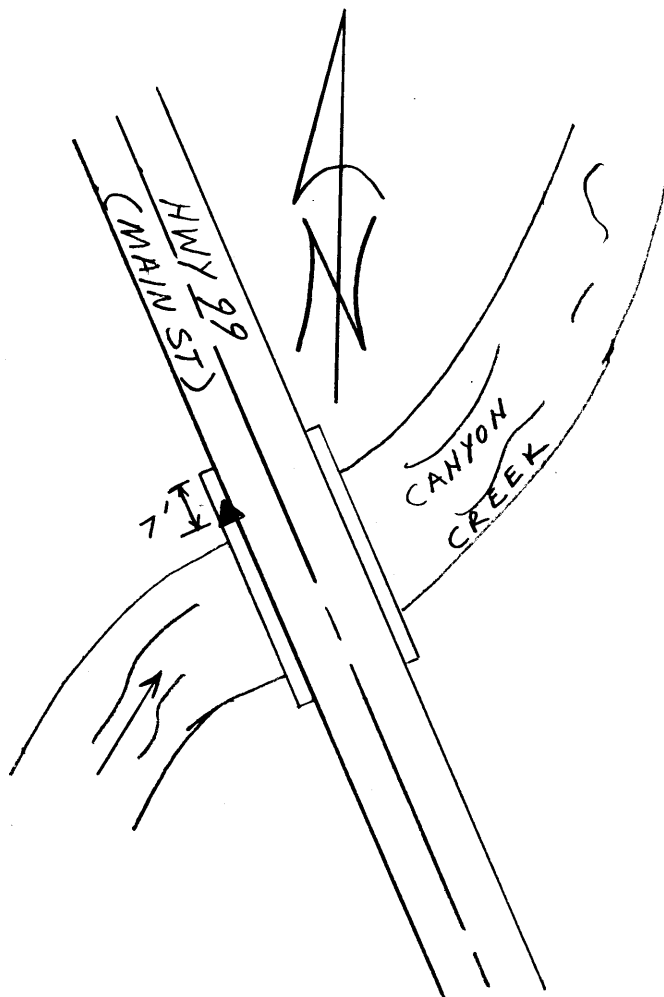

From the intersection of Main Street,

proceed southeasterly along Main Street
approx. 0.15 miles to its crossing of
Canyon Creek and monument in northwest
corner of bridge.
