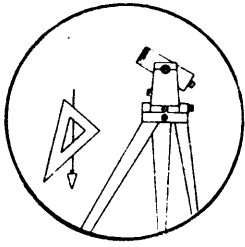
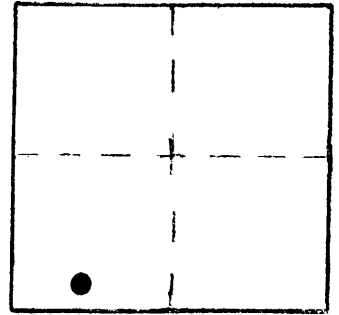

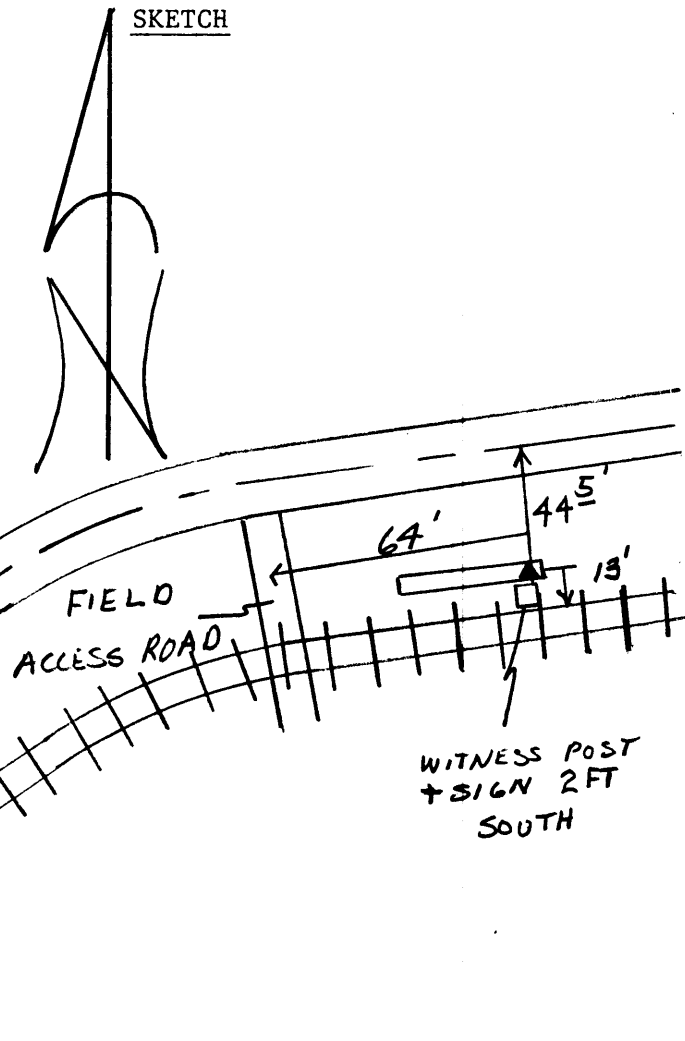

A 3 in. diam. USC&GS disk stamped
"W 552 1954" set in the East end of an 8 1/2 ft.
long by 1 1/2 ft. wide concrete headwall of a
24 in. diameter culvert.

From the intersection of Cow Creek Rd.
(Co. Rd. # 39) and Riddle By-pass Rd. (Co. Rd.
263) in T30S, R6W, Section 23 proceed south-
westerly along Cow Creek Rd. approximately
0.55 miles to monument on left.
