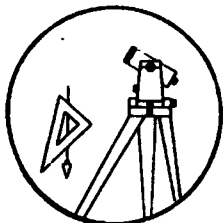
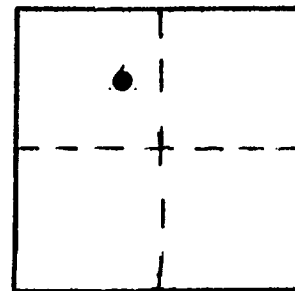

SKETCH

1.2 miles Southwesterly along old road
on top of Divide from intersection of
roads 68, 30, and 800 in T30S,R2E,Sec.33
Monument is on east side of large clearing,
about 180 feet east of and 10 feet above road,
73 feet northeast of a 48 inch dia. fir tree.

Brass Cap in boulder on eastern side of 30 foot
diam pile of rock, grown over with brush, lower
(3') than top of Rock pile.
