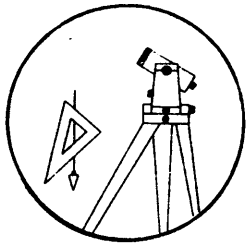


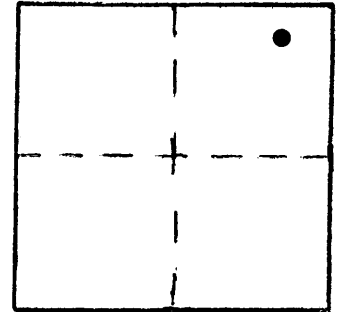

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

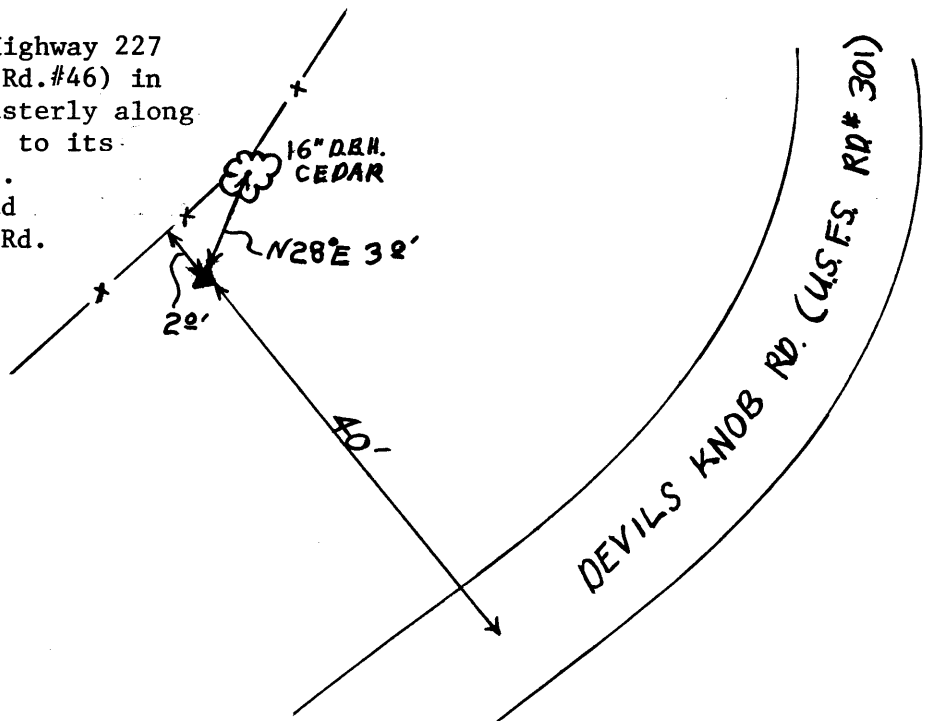
SKETCH

DESCRIPTION:

A USC&GS disk stamped "V500 1949" set in a 12 inch diameter concrete post, protruding 4 inches above ground.

TO REACH:

From the intersection of State Highway 227 and Tiller-South Umpqua Rd. (Co.Rd.#46) in T30S,R2W,Sec.33, proceed southeasterly along State Hwy. 227 approx. 3.6 miles to its intersection with Devils Knob Rd. (U.S.F.S. Rd. #301), then proceed northeasterly along Devils knob Rd. 0.8 miles to monument on left.
