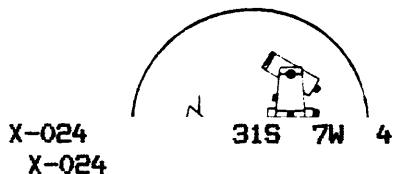
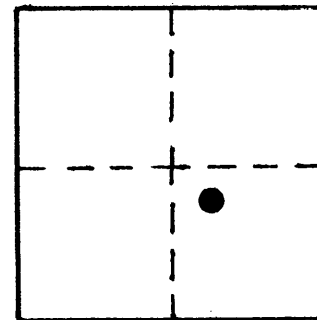

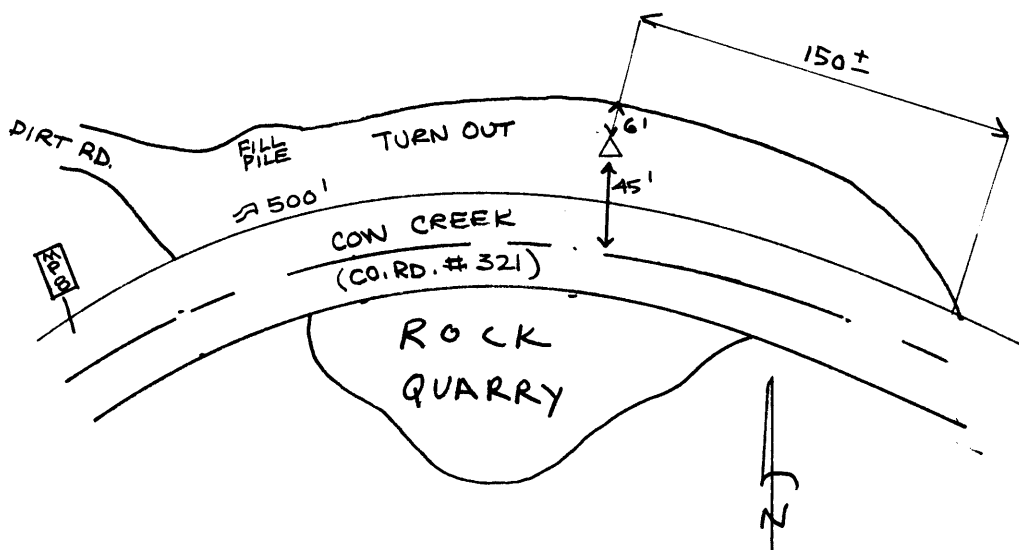

Set: A standard DCSO drillcap stamped "X-024 1991"
flush with ground surface and in top of buried boulder.
To Reach: From the intersection of Doe Creek Rd. (Co.
Rd. #164) and Cow Creek Rd. (Co. Rd. #321) proceed
southwesterly along Cow Creek Rd. approx. 2.45 mi. to monument
on the right.
