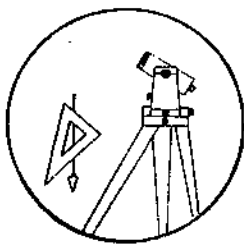
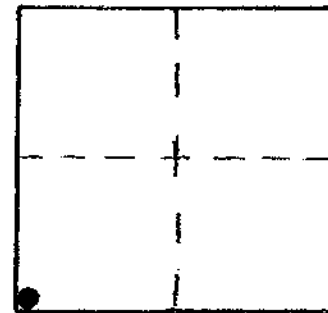

SKETCH

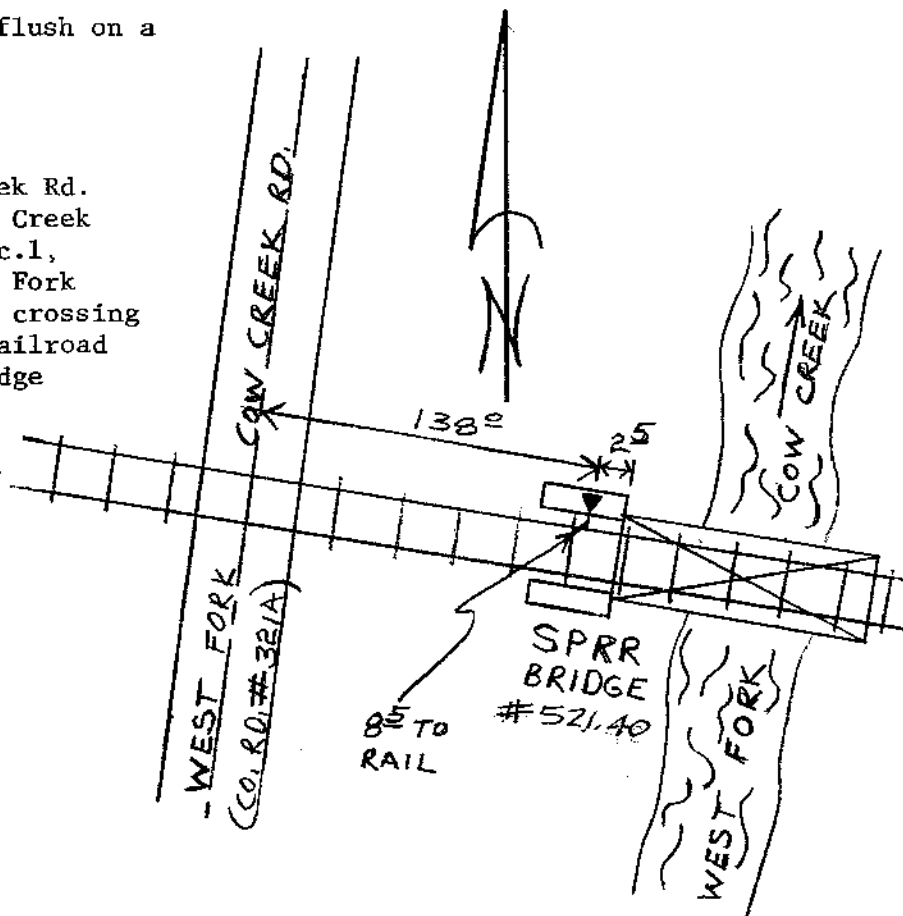
DESCRIPTION:

A disk stamped "J 552 1954" set flush on a concrete SPRR bridge abutment.

TO REACH:

From the intersection of Cow Creek Rd. (Co. Rd. #321) and West Fork Cow Creek Rd. (Co. Rd. #321A) in T32S, R8W, Sec.1, proceed southwesterly along West Fork Cow Creek Rd. 0.10 miles to SPRR crossing monument is 138 ft. east along railroad tracks in the northwest SPRR bridge abutment.
