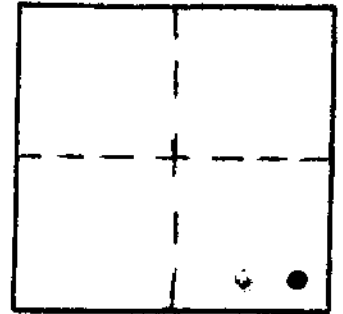

DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

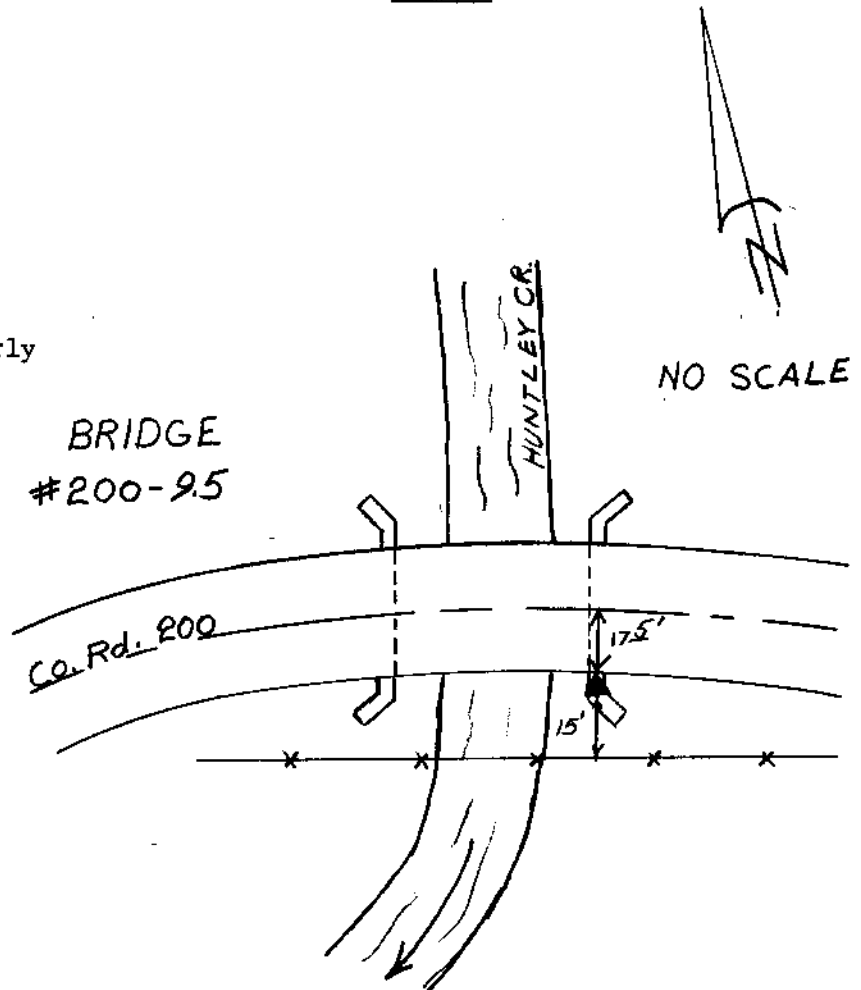
SKETCH

DESCRIPTION:

Monument is a 2½ inch brass cap stamped "200-14.69 1982" set in the SE wing wall of bridge.

TO REACH:

From the intersection of Hwy 99 and Co. Rd. 200 (North Bank Rd.) in T26S,R5W,Sec.18; proceed easterly along Co. Rd. 200, approx 14.7 miles to monument on right.
