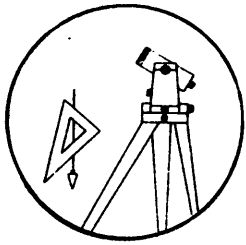
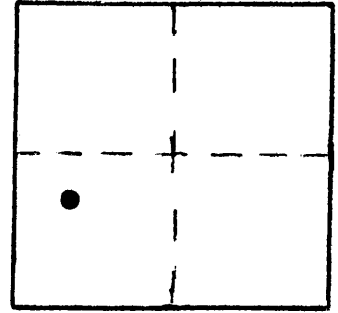

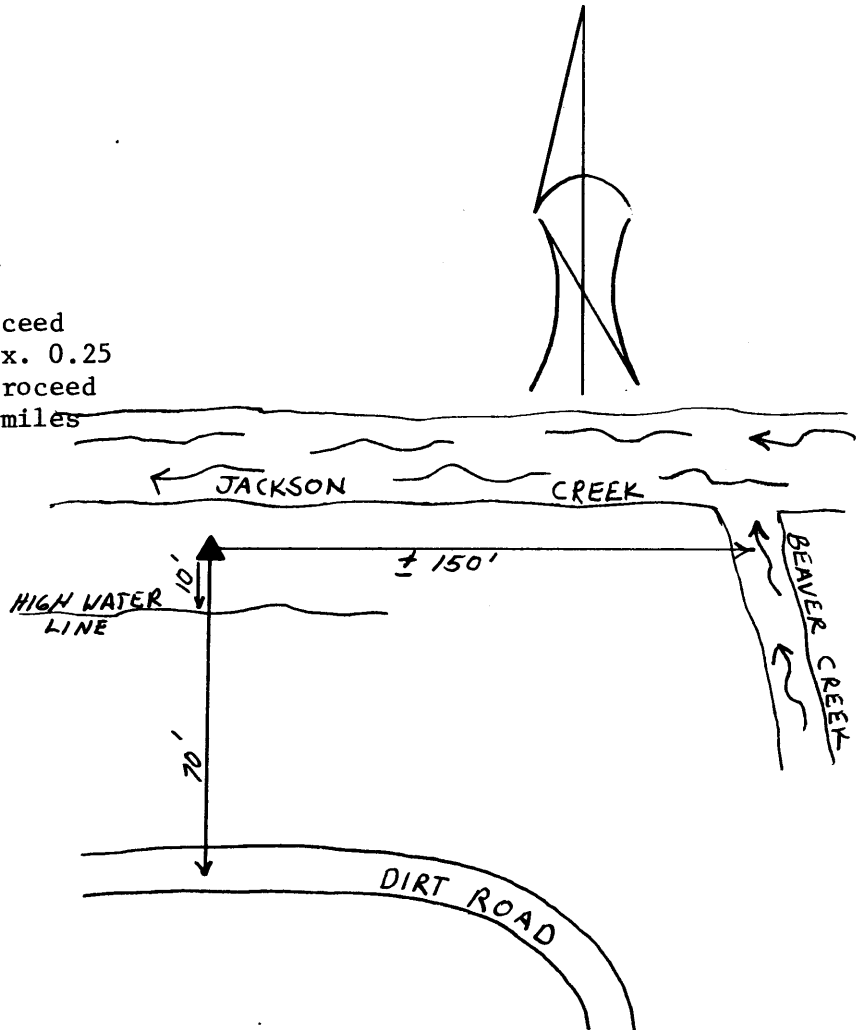
DESCRIPTION and TO REACH

A USGS disk stamped "4 M 1297 1944" set in a 9ft. by 4ft. by 1 1/2 ft. high rock outcrop.

TO REACH:

From the intersection of Jackson Creek Rd. (USFS Rd. #29) and Beaver Creek Rd. (USFS Rd. #31) in T30S, R1W, Sec.22, proceed southeasterly along USFS Rd. #31 approx. 0.25 miles to unmarked dirt road on left, proceed northerly along dirt road approx. 0.1 miles to monument on right.
