

NOTICE OF CREATION OF TYEE LIVESTOCK DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that at an election held August 10, 1976, the formation TYEE LIVESTOCK DISTRICT was approved by the voters of the district. The district has boundaries described as:

Beginning on the West boundary of an existing Livestock District and on the line between Range 5 West and Range 6 West of the Willamette Meridian where said line passes through the corner common to Sections 1 and 12, Township 24 South, Range 6 West and Sections 6 and 7, Township 24 South, Range 5 West, Willamette Meridian; Douglas County, Oregon; thence West along the sections lines to the corner common to sections 3, 4, 9 and 10, Township 24 South, Range 7 West; thence South along the Sections line to the South East Corner of said Section 9; thence West to the South East Corner of Section 8, said Township and Range; thence South to the South East corner of Section 17 in said Township and Range; thence West to the South West corner of Section 17; thence South to the South East corner of Section 19 in said Township and Range; thence West to the South West corner of Section 19 in said Township and Range; thence South along the line between Range 7 West and Range 8 West, Willamette Meridian to a point where said line intersects the thread of the Umpqua River; thence upstream along the thread of said stream to the boundary of the existing livestock district; thence along the boundary of the existing livestock district to the point of beginning all in Douglas County, Oregon.

From and after 60 days from the date of first publication of this notice it shall be unlawful for all classes of livestock to run at large within the boundaries of the livestock district. No person having the custody, possession or control of a livestock animal shall permit such animal to run at large or to be herded, pastured or go upon the land of another within the district. Any person violating the provisions of ORS 607.045 is guilty of a misdemeanor and may be punished by a maximum fine of \$1,000 or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one year or both.
