

**NOTICE OF CREATION OF OLALLA-TENMILE LIVESTOCK
DISTRICT.**

Whereas, on the 16th day of May, 1952, an election was held in Olalla Precinct, Douglas County, Oregon, for the creation of a livestock district to be known as Olalla-Tenmile Livestock District, described as follows:

All of Olalla Precinct bounded as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest Corner of Section 18, Township 28 South, Range 8 West of the Willamette Meridian in Douglas County, Oregon, running thence east 8 miles to the northeast corner of Section 17, Township 28 South, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence south 1 mile; east 3 miles to the northeast corner of Section 23, Township 28 South, Range 7 West, W.M.; thence south 7 miles to the southeast corner of Section 23, Township 29 South, Range 7 West, W.M.; west 1 mile; south 2 miles to the southeast corner of Section 34, Township 29 South, Range 7 West, W.M.; thence west 7 miles to the southwest corner of Section 34, Township 29 South, Range 8 West, W.M.; thence north 6 miles; west 3 miles; north 4 miles to the place of beginning, being the whole of Olalla Voting Precinct in Douglas County, Oregon, as duly established by order of the county court of Douglas County, Oregon.

and at said election a majority of all votes cast at said election in said precinct were in favor of creation of said livestock district.

Therefore, notice is hereby given that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice it shall be unlawful for livestock to run at large within the boundaries of said livestock district.

Any person owning or having the custody, possession or control of any livestock, namely, any bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine, who shall herd or permit any such livestock to run or be at large, or run at large therein shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and Justice, District and Circuit Courts shall have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of such misdemeanors.

NOTICE OF CREATION OF THE OAK CREEK LIVESTOCK DISTRICT

Whereas, on the 16th day of May, 1952, an election was held by the qualified voters of the territory described herein for the creation of a livestock district, to be known as The Oak Creek Livestock District in Douglas County, Oregon, described as follows:

Commencing at that point where the Eastern boundary of the right-of-way of County Road #4 intersects the East and West boundary line running between the Theodore Prather Donation Land Claim and the James Oden Donation Land Claim; thence East along said East and West boundary line to the South East corner of the Lottie McHuggill property, thence North along the Eastern boundary of the said Lottie McHuggill property to that point where it is intersected by the Northern boundary of the R. A. Raper Donation Land Claim; thence East along the said Northern boundary of the R. A. Raper Donation Land Claim to that point where said boundary is intersected by the North and South line separating Sections 27 and 28, T 26 S, R 4 W, W. M.; thence North along the line separating sections 27 and 28, T 26 S, R 4 W, W.M., to the North West corner of Section 27; thence East along the northern boundary of Section 27 to that point where it is intersected by the line running North and South between the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 22, T 26 S, R 4 W, W. M., and the $E\frac{1}{2}$ of the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of said Section 22; thence North along the said North and South line to that point where it is intersected by the Southern boundary line of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of the said Section 22; thence East along said Southern boundary line and along the Southern boundaries of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, and the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T 26 S, R 4 W, W.M., to that point where said Southern boundary is intersected by the Western boundary of the Wm. Trask Donation Land Claim; thence North along the Western boundary of the Wm. Trask Donation Land Claim to that point where it is intersected by the Southern boundary of the right-of-way of County Road #4; thence in a Southwesterly direction along the Southerly and Easterly boundary of the right-of-way of said County Road #4 across Sections 22, 21, and 29, T 26 S, R 4 W, W.M., to the place of beginning, containing 1280 acres, more or less, in Sections 21, 22, 28, and 29, T 26 S, R 4 W, W.M.;

and at said election a majority of all votes cast at said election in said district were in favor of creation of said livestock district.

Therefore, notice is hereby given that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice it shall be unlawful for livestock to run at large within the boundaries of said livestock district.

Any person owning or having the custody, possession or control of any livestock, namely; any bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine, who shall herd or permit any such livestock to run or be at large or to run at large therein shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and Justice, District and Circuit Courts shall have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of such misdemeanors.
