Whereas, on the 4th day of November, 1952, an election was held in Melrose and Lookingglass Precincts in Douglas County, Oregon, for the creation of a livestock district to be known as West Melrose-Flournoy Valley Livestock District in said county, comprising the following territory:

All of Sections 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 32 and 33, all in Township 27 South, Range 7 West of the Willamette Meridian in Douglas County, Oregon.

And at said election a majority of all votes cast by the qualified electors of said proposed district were in favor of the creation of said livestock district.

Therefore, notice is hereby given that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice it shall be unlawful for livestock to run at large within the boundaries of said West Melrose-Flournoy Valley Livestock District, and any person owning or having in custody, possession or control of any livestock, namely, any bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine, who shall herd or permit any such livestock to run or be at large, or run at large therein shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and Justice, District and Circuit Courts shall have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of such misdemeanors.
