Whereas, on the 4th day of November, 1952, an election was held in East Umpqua and Dixonville Precincts in Douglas County, Oregon, for the creation of a livestock district to be known as the Little River Livestock District in said county, comprising the following territory:

All of Sections 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33 and 34 in Township 26 South of Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian;

All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 in Township 27 South of Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian;

All of Sections 2, 3, 6, 10, 11, 12 and 14 in Township 27 South of Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian; and

All of Sections 1, 12 and 13 in Township 27 South of Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian.

And at said election a majority of all votes cast by the qualified electors of said proposed district were in favor of the creation of said livestock district.

Therefore, notice is hereby given that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice it shall be unlawful for livestock to run at large within the boundaries of said Little River Livestock District, and any person owning or having the custody, possession or control of any livestock, namely, any bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine, who shall herd or permit any such livestock to run or be at large, or run at large therein shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and Justice, District and Circuit Courts shall have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of such misdemeanors.
