**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM THE

Whereas, on the 4th day of November, 1952, an election was held in Olalla Precinct in Douglas County, Oregon, for withdrawal of the following described territory from the Olalla-Tenmile Livestock District, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 15, Township 29 South, Range 7 West of Willamette Meridian in Douglas County, Oregon, running thence east 2 miles, thence south 2 miles, thence west 1 mile, thence south 2 miles, thence west 2 miles, thence north one-half mile, thence east one-half mile, thence north one-half mile, thence west one-fourth mile, thence North 2 miles, thence east three-fourths mile, thence north 1 mile to the place of beginning.

And at said election a majority of all votes cast by the qualified electors of the area proposed to be withdrawn were in favor of withdrawing said area from said livestock district.

Therefore, notice is hereby given that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice it shall be lawful for livestock to run at large within the area above described, and said area declared to have been withdrawn from said Olalla-Tenmile Livestock District by virtue of said election.
