NOTICE OF CREATION OF ELK LIVESTOCK DISTRICT

Whereas, on the 21st day of May, 1954, an election was held in the South Drain Precinct, Douglas County, Oregon, for the creation of a Livestock District to be known as the Elk Livestock District, described as follows, to-wit

"That portion of Sections 11, 12, 13 and 14, Township 22 South, Range 6 West, Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon, lying South of State Highway Number 38 (Reedsport-Drain Highway)."

and at said election a majority of all votes cast at said election held in said district were in favor of creation of said Livestock District.

Therefore, notice is hereby given that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice it shall be un-lawfull for livestock to run at large within the boundaries of said Livestock District.

Any person owning or having the custody, possession or control of any livestock, namely, any bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine, who shall herd or permit any such livestock to run or be at large therein shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and Justice, District and Circuit Courts shall have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of such misdemeanors.
