PROCLAMATION- Establishing the Comstock

Whereas, pursuant to ORS 607,010, there having been filed with the County Clerk, of Douglas County, Oregon, a duly signed petition containing more than 6 names of legal voters from within the herein described area requesting a special election to be held at the same time and place as the Primary Election May 18, 1956, for the Comstock Voting Precinct, for the purpose of establishing a livestock control district to be known as the Comstock Livestock Control District. It being the purpose of the petition to establish a livestock control district to prevent livestock from running at large in the following described area, to-wit:

"Beginning on the Douglas County line at the center of the North boundary of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence South following the county line 7 miles to the South boundary of Section 2, Township 22 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence West to the South West corner of Section 6, Township 22 South, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence North 1 mile; thence West 5 miles to the South West corner of Section 32, Township 21 South, Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence North 6 miles to the North West corner of Section 5, Township 21 South, Range 5 West of the Willamette Meridian; thence East along the county line 9 1/2 miles to the place of beginning, all in Douglas County, Oregon."

And whereas 3 notices of such election were issued by the County Clerk of Douglas County, Oregon, and caused to be posted in three conspicuous and public places within the above described area for a period of 45 days prior to said election, and whereas said election was held May 18, 1956 within the above described area in which all legal voters of the described area were given opportunity to vote on the above matter, and the votes having been counted and duly canvassed, there having been 84 votes cast for the formation of the said stock control district, and 47 votes cast against the formation of the said stock control district:

I, Chas Doerner, County Clerk of Douglas County, Oregon, hereby give public notice of the establishment of The Comstock Livestock Control District composed of the above described area in which "ORS 607.045 No person owning or having the custody, possession or control of any livestock shall herd or permit such livestock to run at large in any territory where it is unlawful for such livestock to be herded or to run at large. Justice, district and circuit courts have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of violations of this section." ORS 607.005 defines "livestock" to mean "cattle of the bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine"

The above district is hereby established, and all laws relating to the enforcement of such district shall become effective on the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice.
