Pursuant to O R S 607.040, I, Chas. Doerner, County Clerk of Douglas County, State of Oregon, do hereby give notice, that at the general election held November 6, 1956, at the regular voting places for East Riddle and West Riddle voting precincts an election was duly held pursuant to Oregon Law for the purpose of establishing a livestock control district to be known as the RIDDLE LIVESTOCK CONTROL DISTRICT within the following described area, to-wit:

"Commencing at the northwest corner of Section 18, Township 30 South, Range 6 West, W.M.; thence easterly following the section lines to the northeast corner of Section 13 of said township and range; thence southerly following the section lines to the southeast corner of Section 1, Township 31, Range 6 West, W.M.; thence westerly following the section lines to the southwest corner of Section 6 of said Township 31 South, Range 6 West, W.M.; thence northerly following the section lines to the place of beginning; all in Douglas County, Oregon."

And, whereas at such election 494 persons voted to prohibit livestock from running at large in the above described area and 125 persons voted against prohibiting livestock from running at large therein:

Notice is hereby given that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice no person owning or having the custody, possession or control of any livestock shall herd or permit such livestock to run or be at large in any of the above described area. "Livestock" as defined by this act means Cattle of the bovine species, Horses, Mules, Asses, Sheep, Goats and Swine.

Justice, district and circuit courts have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of violations of this section.
