PROCLAMATION OF DISTRICT

Whereas, pursuant to ORS. 607.010 and relating statutes, a duly signed and acknowledged petition was presented to the County Court of Douglas County and filed by the County Clerk February 27, 1957, requesting that an election be held for the purpose of creating a Livestock District to be known by the name GLENDALE-AZALEA LIVESTOCK DISTRICT, and it being the purpose of creating such district to prohibit livestock from running at large therein;

And, Whereas, pursuant to an order of the County Court dated February 28, 1957, an election was called and conducted as provided by law to vote on the formation of such district in the following area as set fourth in the aforementioned petition; to-wit:


"Beginning at the Douglas-Josephine County line at the S W corner Sec. 11, Twp 33 South, Range 7 West, W.M.; thence North 5 miles to the N W corner of Sec. 23, Twp 32 South, Range 7 West, W.M.; thence East 10 miles to the S W corner of Sec. 16, Twp 32 South, Range 5 West, W.M.; thence North 1 mile; thence East 1 mile; thence North 3 miles to the N W corner of Sec. 34, Twp 31 South, Range 5 West, W.M.; thence East 4 miles to the N E corner Sec. 31, Twp 31 South, Range 4 West, W.M. which point is also on the West line of the Galesville Livestock District; thence Southerly and Easterly along the boundary line of the Galesville Livestock District as follows: South $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles, West $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, South $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, East $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, South 1 mile, East 3 miles to the N E corner of Sec. 15, Twp 32 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and thence South to the South Douglas County line; thence following the South Douglas County line in a Westerly direction to the S W corner of Sec. 11, Township 33 South, Range 7 West, Willamette Meridian, the place of beginning, and all being located in Douglas County, Oregon."

And, whereas, at said election conducted April 22nd 1957, between the hours of 8.00 A.M. and 8 P.M. at the Glendale Highschool wherein all legal voters for such election from within the above described area had opportunity to express their votes; whereas at such election as evidenced by the official canvas of the Douglas County Court of April 26, 1957, there were 81 votes cast in favor of the formation of said district, and there were 28 votes cast against the formation of said district;

Therefore, I, CHAS DOERNER, COUNTY CLERK OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, OREGON, PURSUANT TO ORS. 607.040, DO HEREBY GIVE PUBLIC NOTICE, that on and after the sixtieth day from the first date of the first publication of this notice it shall be unlawful for livestock to run at large within the boundaries of the above described area which shall be known as the Glendale-Azalea Livestock District. ("Livestock" means cattle of the bouvine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine.)

"Justice, district and circuit courts have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of violations of this section."
