PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to ORS 607.040, I, G. D. Myllenbeck, County Clerk of Douglas County, Oregon, do hereby give notice that at the General Election held on November 6, 1962, at the regular polling places for the Tri-City East precinct and the Canyonville East precinct an election was held pursuant to Oregon Law for the establishment of a livestock control district to be known as the Surprise Valley Livestock Control District within the following described area, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Section 23, T 30 S, R 5 W, WM, Douglas County, Oregon; thence West along the north line of Sections 23, 22, and 21 to the quarter section corner common to Sections 16 and 21; thence north along the half section lines in Sections 16 and 9 and continuing to the center of Section 4; thence east to the quarter section corner common to Sections 3 and 4; thence north along the east line of Section 4 to the Northeast corner of Section 4; thence west along the north line of Sections 4 and 5 to the easterly right-of-way line of the Myrtle Creek Secondary Road; also known as U. S. Highway No. 99 Business Route; thence in a Southerly direction following said Easterly right-of-way line to the junction of said highway with the Riddle Road in Section 7; thence Westerly along the Southerly right-of-way line of said Riddle Road to the junction of said road with U. S. Interstate Highway No. 5, also known as U. S. Highway No. 99 Freeway; thence Southerly along the Easterly right-of-way line of said highway to the North bank of the South Umpqua River; thence Easterly following said North bank to the West line of Section 26; thence South along said line to the Northerly right-of-way line of Highway No. 42; thence Easterly along the said Northerly right-of-way line to the East line of Section 23; thence North along said line to the place of beginning, all in Township 30 South, Range 5, West, Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon.

And whereas at said election 290 persons voted to prohibit livestock from running at large in the above described area, and 85 persons voted against prohibiting livestock from running at large.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on and after the sixtieth day from the date of the first publication of this notice no person owning or having the custody, possession or control of any livestock shall herd or permit such livestock to run or be at large in any of the above described area, "Livestock" as defined by this act means cattle of the bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine.

Justice, District and Circuit Courts have concurrent jurisdiction of actions for the prosecution of violations of this section.
