

Low Creek July 12th 1869

Paswant to Call, over the names of Low
Creek, having met at the House of
Dougherty and Hammons to enact
Laws and Regulations to govern this
Dist. do Resolve as follows,

Article 1st

That this district be known as Low Creek
District commencing at Middle Creek
on the west and terminating at the
State Road on the East including
all tributaries of Low Creek,

Article 2nd

That Hill Claims shall be two hundred
yards front running back four
hundred yards,

Article 3rd

That Gulch or Ravine claims shall be
one hundred yards wide by two hundred
yds long.

Article 4th

That Creek Claims be fifty yards wide
twenty five yards on each side from
the center of the Creek, by one hundred
and fifty yards long.

Article 5th

That water Rights be governed by the
general custom of the Country,

Article 6th

That bar claims shall be known as
flats lying on the creek at one high
water mark - fifty yards wide
by one hundred yards long.

Article 7th

That hill gulch and bar claims be
represented from Dec 1st to June 1st,
