Petition for a Road
from Wm. P. Days to
Cammass Mountain

Now at this day was presented a petition signed by John Stanley and 25 others praying for the location of a County Road in Cammass Valley wd

Beginning at a point 38.00 ch. E and 4.00 N of the S.W. corner of W. P. Days Donation claim thence in a North Easterly direction on the present travelled Road terminating at the nearest terminus of the Barker Survey of a County Road at or near the Summit of Cammass Valley Mountain

And the said Petitioners having filed a Bond in the sum of \$200.00 as by law required together with proof that legal notice had been given, Also that 12 or more of said Petitioners are
