

Survey of Road done August 22^d 1892

Beginning at a Point Seventeen chains and fifty Links South of N. C. Corner of John Yokum Donation Claim on the North and South line between John Yokums and William, Prestons Donation Claim At a Stake marked C.R. on the present traveled Road, witness by Black Oak Tree 12 inches Diameter marked C.R. Bearings S 80° E Distance 20 Links

Thence N 77° W 25.57 ch to South end of John Yokum Tole Bridge across South Tumpshaw River

Thence N 75° W 3.00 ch across said Bridge to a Stake on the bank about fifty feet from the end of said Bridge

Thence S 30° W 12.00 ch to Terminus of proposed changed Road at a Stake marked C.R. in front of John Yokum House on the present traveled Road witness by Black Oak Tree marked C.R. 15 in Diameter Bearings N 6° E 1.74 ch
