The Petitioner concerning a petition for the location of a County Road from N. W. Newland in Steens Co. to intersect the Coos Bay Road near Girdney, and said petitioners having filed a sufficient Bond in the sum of two hundred Dollars and gave that notice has been given as by law required. It is ordered that Benjamin C. Lee William Jenkins and John C. be and they are appointed viewers and William H. Briggs Surveyor to meet at William Mell's Black Smith Shop in ten mile precinct on April 24<sup>th</sup> 1873 and view Surrey and locate the said Road as herein far in the petition
