Beginning at a point 33.13 ch West of a S.E. corner of John Jones lance. at a post set for a S.W. corner of a 50.65 acres tract of land belonging to J. M. Caswell and on the North boundary of E. M. Moore lance In T 27. S. R. 6 W. Sec 14.

Var 19 1/2 E.

Thence North 24.22 ch to point in center of County road leading to Roseburg. Thence S 72 1/2 E 4.46 ch to point in same road. Thence South 22.88 ch to post set on North boundary of E. M. Moore lance. and Thence West 4.25 ch to place of Beginning containing 10 acres

Made May 4 & 5<sup>th</sup> 1894. W. J. Chadwick and Henry Amerson sworn chain carriers.

The object of this Survey is for the purpose of establishing the boundary lines between J. Chadwick and J. J. Cooper. on the North and East of a tract of land now owned by J. J. Cooper formerly belonging to the Donation claim of R. E. Stratton. Claim number 38.

Beginning at the S.W. corner of cl no 38. and N.W. corner of cl no 48. established corner as per original B.T. T. 25. S. R. 5 W. and Sec 31.

Var 19 1/2 E.

Thence North 10.50 ch. to post Thence S 89° 40' E. 49.40 ch The course ~~and~~ distance being the same as given in the Field Notes of the Survey of cl no 38. set post marked C.S. from which W Oak 24 in dia bears N 43 1/2 E. 15.26 links dist. Thence South at 9.25 ch intersect subdivision line of Sec 32. and at 10.50 ch set post for S.E. cor of cl no 38. The B.T. for this corner has been destroyed. See plat on page 1 Sur no 1
