

Survey No. *Five*

Made for *Williamson & Co*

Aug 22-23, 1894

T26S. R.5W.

I commence this survey at the corner of sections 29-30-31-32 Town 26S R.5W. which I set from the original witness trees which I find in place B Dixon & W. Woodley acting as chainman I run north 20 chains set a cedar post for the corner of B Dixon & Williamson & Co Land @ W.C. Bears S 89° W-82° @ Maple 13<sup>in</sup> Bears N 22° W 83<sup>l</sup> Thence E 40 chains to G.W. Jones plank fence set an oak post for the corner of B Dixon & Williamson & Co land @ B.C. Bears N. 1° 19<sup>l</sup> Thence <sup>North</sup> on a Random line Va. 17.35-E. as sighted in field notes for the W line of this section I continue this line to the S bank of the North Umpqua River a large fir with a dead top stands 30 links west of line this tree bears marks of a prior survey I now go to the corner of sections 17-18-19 & 20 which I set from the original notes the trees being in place with some slight difference in measurement - I now run East with Ed. Bent & W. Woodley sworn chainmen 20 chains set a post for the NW corner of the Flint Donation @ B.C. 24<sup>th</sup> Bears S. 7° 30' E-87<sup>l</sup> Thence S 40 chains to the waters edge of the Umpqua River set a post from which an Alder 22<sup>in</sup> Bears N 1° E. 50<sup>l</sup> I now return to the above described sec lot & run East 39.86° to the gr Post in Short's field I set said Post from the original Post-witness trees I now sight my instrument to my fir tree on the S bank of River & find my Random line very nearly correct the va of middle Reading 17° 40' instead of 17° 35' for the S end of line given under my hand This 24<sup>th</sup> day of August - A.D. 1894
