For the Purpose of finding the contents of a Tract of land Deeded to J Pearson by the Dumbbltons I begin at a Point where the Land of John Jones Comes to the Right-of Way of the S P RR & Measure South 7-44 Chains along the line of Jones Land Thence E. 6-58 Chains to the RR Right-of Way Thence following the Curve & Tangent of the RR, 10-17 links to the place of beginning contents of Tract 2 acres & 6/100 more or less

To Establish the Section Line from the corner of Sections 11-12-13 & 14. South to the gr Post. I begin at the Section corner above said north and run South 1/4" 207' E at 20 chs & mark a point on line at 40' & 17 lks & fall E of the 1/4 Post which was originally an ash, the stump still standing on the bank of small creek I now return to my point on line at 20 chs. & move said point South 8 1/2 lks & 2 lks West & set a stone firmly in ground for the corner of W L Laird's land & the Inside corner of A W Johnson's Land.
