In the matter of a change in the County Road
 Petitioned for by S W Peters, I met with the
 Viewers Messrs H. C. Underwood & R. Harrington
 A J Dear. in Oakland Precinct. on the
 22nd day of Sept AD 1899 and under their
 directions proceeded to survey said Road
 as petitioned for conspicuously marking the
 same through out and noting the courses
 and distances & I hereby certify that the
 following is a correct return of the survey
 of said Road and plat thereof

Beginning at the North
 End of the North Bridge over Kallapa wa Creek
 at the S W corner of S W Peters' Land
 in the center of the old Road leading to
 Green Valley, Va 20° E & Run N 37° W along the
 Green Valley Road 5-50. Thence N 37° W. 1-65
 Thence N 12° E 3-44 Thence N 34° E 3-70 Thence
 N 45° 30' E 3-14 To a Point 30ft South of H P Harrington
 Land Thence E & Parallel to said Harringtons Land
 6-15 To a Point 30ft South and 30ft East of
 the South East corner of said Harringtons
 Land Thence North to the same being the
 center of Sec 33 T. 24 S R 5 W. Thence N 13.85°
 Thence N 42° E 3-95 Thence N 84° E 6-95 Thence N 24° E
 5-13. Along the Yoncalla Road Thence E 3-00 Thence
 South 46° 30' E Two chains to cross in the present
 Travelled Road to cross fence, a White oak Post set
 as the Law requires from which a double White oak 16"
 Bears N 18° W 1-02 & a White oak 14" bears N 82° E 1-00
 I find said change to be 14-96 chains longer than the
 present ^{cut fork} Travelled Road, ^{and 4.83 on Yoncalla Road} whole length being 58-46
 width of Road 60ft as per Plat on opposite
 page Given under my hand this
