T. 28 S. R. 7 W. To set the center of this section  
I begin at the gr Post on the North side of  
the section & run South to the gr Post on the South  
body of sec. which I establish from one of the witness  
trees now fallen (the W O) S 17° 15' W. 377 lks. Said tree  
being identified by N. J. Richards as the original  
Witness tree, the other tree still standing @ 180<sup>mm</sup>  
diam S 40° W 87 lks. distant. And from the gr  
Post on the West side of the section I run a  
line through the center of the section to the  
1/4 Post on the East side of the section & at  
the intersection of these 2 lines I set the center  
of the section 40.06 from the gr Post on the  
West side of the section & 40 Chs from the 1/4 Post  
on the North side of the section. Set a White  
oak Post. I also divide the Tho lands of  
N. J. Richards & J. L. Parker, by running a line  
East and West through the center of the South  
1/2 of the section equal distances from the Sec  
Corners and the 1/4 Posts on the East & West sides  
of the section The East line being 42 Chs long  
& the West line being 40.11 Chs long The Chairman  
were not sworn under, agreement of J. L. Parker  
& N. J. Richards one of them being an interested party
