To Establish The Line between The Sol. Williamson Donation Land claim No 55. & The Reason Reed Donation Land claim No 58 in sections 5-6-7-8. Township 25 S Range 5 W M. M. I begin survey at the S.E. corner of The Williamson claim which I establish from the stump of The original B.T. by setting a W Oak Post firmly in ground from which a White Oak 16 in dia bears N. 12-30. W. 1.22 links I run with the recited bearing N. 12° W. 20. N. 20° E. 71 chains at 54.25° I cross West boundary of claim 58. 96 links East of N.W. corner showing that the true bearing of this line should be N. 13° W. At this point I set the N.W. cor. of claim 58 a stone 14x6x4. From the original B.T. a W O 30 in dia N. 80° E. .85 links Dist I now continue this line from the last described corner. N. 13° W. 16.73 links set the N.E. cor. of claim No 55. a stone 16x5x5. from which a W Oak bears N. 10° W. 5.10 links at this station local attraction disturbs the needle for which I make no subtraction or addition for on course to the B.T. I now run the original B.T. to this corner has been cut down from the stump to the corner the compass reading is N. 73° E. from the corner to the stump S. 88° W. recited course S. 87° W. 3.39 links which is the true distance giving correctness to my position of the corner I now set a flag at the first position the S.E. corner of claim 58, which I can see from the N.E. cor. of said claim & direct my sight to the flag & find the corner of the S.W. corner of claim 58. to be correct in line I now go to the gr Post between Secs 6 & 7 & run a line S. 6.47 links the distance recited in the field notes. to the N line of claim 55. I set the S.E. cor. of Lot No 3 in Sec 6 a stone 16x6x4 from which a W O 25 in dia bears N. 46 links I now return to the gr Post I run West 19.933 links 1/4 recited distance of the section set a stone for corner 16x10x4 from which a W O 20 in dia bears S 19° E. 588 Dist thence S. 1127 links to donation
