Begin at the N.E. cor of D. A. Levens D.L.C. No 38 in
S 32 S.R. 5-M. Set post as per original B.T. standing to wit:
B Oak 18 in dia bears S 70° W. 47 lbs. Bar 19° 30' E.
Thence West 50.00 ch set post enclosed C 38. C.S. no tree near
Thence South 20.00 ch set post in wheat field C 38. C.S.
Thence West 20.00 ch. set post as per original B.T. to wit:
B Oak 18 in dia bears S 50° E. 15 lbs
Thence South 26.00 ch Co Road. 31.45-ch set post on
gravel bar of Cow Creek the original B.T. has been washed
out by ^{high} water made new B.T. to wit: Maple 12 in dia N 7 1/2° E. 117 lbs
Thence East 70.13 ch intersect at S.E. cor wit tree standing
set post from which Fir 14 in dia bears N 40° W. 44 lbs
Thence North 51.45-ch to place of beginning Cont 321.95-acres
The West half of the above tract of land is to be
set off to Grant Levens. for this purpose I commence at
the N.E. cor of cl 38 and run West 30.97 3/4 ch.
set post - from which. B Oak 8 in dia bears S 1° 30' W. 18 lbs
W Oak 6 in dia bears N 85 1/4° E. 37 lbs.
Thence South on division line at 15.00 ch Levens big
barn on the line said line cutting about 20 feet off
the West half 51.95-ch intersect South boundary
line. set post - from which W. Fir 8 in dia bears N 35 1/2° E.
13 lbs. W Fir 8 in dia bears N 44 1/4° W. 48 lbs.
Thence East 30.97 3/4 ch to S.E. cor. before mentioned
Thence North 51.95-ch to N.E. and starting point -
Cont 160.93 acres.

July 19 - 1900

Started from the S.E. cor of cl 38 run South 33.5-ch
marked W. Fir C.S. for cor from which Maple 6 in dia
bears N 64° E. 28 lbs. Thence East 40.00 ch set post
S.E. cor of A Levens "A" - from which, Fir 16 in dia bears
N 38° E. 18 lbs

July 20 -

Thence South 20.00 intersect 1/4 S cor set new post
as per original B.T. standing, W Oak 10 in dia bears S 30° W. 23 1/2 lbs
Thence S 89° 45' E. 40.20 ch intersect at cor of sec 22, 23, 26 & 28
