Thence West 40.00 ch intersect 10 lbs south of tree cor  
 to sees 16, 17, 20 & 21.  
 set post as per original B.T.

Thence South 20.00 ch set post - from which  
 B Oak 14 in dia bears  $N 47^{\circ} E$  50 lbs

Thence East 20.00 ch marked W Oak 6 in dia for cor - from  
 W Oak 10 in dia bears  $S 41^{\circ} W$  13 lbs.

Thence South 6.00 ch marked W Oak 5 in dia  
 for cor - from which W Oak 12 in dia bears  $N 19^{\circ} W$  28 lbs.

Made new division line between the land of  
 Grant Lewis and Estate. to wit:

From the same point on North boundary line  
 of Cl 38. Thence  $S 1^{\circ} 15' E$  14.07 ch to center of northern  
 end of big barn.

Thence  $S 12^{\circ} 30' E$  1.83 ch through barn lengthwise  
 Thence from southern end of barn south  
 36.09 ch to south boundary of Cl 38.

This makes a difference of 2.76 acres added  
 to the west half or part set off to Grant Lewis  
 makes 163.69 acres
