Thence measuring off 16 ft. parallel with 2nd St. thence 24 ft. at right angles with 2nd St. thence 16 ft. parallel with said St. thence 24 ft. at right angles with said St. to the place of beginning.

Survey of a change in County Road leading from Canyonville to Days Creek John Jackson, Pete Ulum and Jacob Brown viewers, and W. F. Briggs surveyor, met at Canyonville as per order of County Court, and after being sworn took to our assistance, John Bray, Thos. Butler, as chairmen, and Peter L. Ulum, marker, sworn.

Set post 4 in sq. 3 1/2 ft long scrubbed P. from which a white oak 8 in dia. bars, S 79° W. 106 lks. a black oak 30 in dia bars S. 69° E. 125 lks. and the inner corner of the Donation land claim of George T. Day Claim No 47, bars, N 39 1/2° W. 216 lks. Post, 30 S. R 4 W.

Thence N 89° W. 4.00 ch. thence N 65° W. 7.00 ch. thence N 72° W. 3.71 ch. thence S 86° W. 3.50 ch. Set terminal post 4x4 in 3 1/2 ft long scrubbed P. from which a B. Oak 20 in dia bars N 43° E 45 lks. a W. Oak 6 in dia bars S 70° E 78 lks and the northerly end of covered bridge over the Cent. Umpqua River. to S. 39° W. 75 lks. main corner of said bridge bars S. 10° W. thence on old road N. 81° E 4.50 ch. thence S 86° E 8.55 ch. thence S 47° E 6.02 to starting point of said road.
