

County Surveyor's Record, Douglas County, Oregon

Tp. 27, R 4  
Secs. 15 and 22

This survey was made Mar. 19th. 1904 to locate the boundary lines between the E 1/2 and the W 1/2 of Sec. 22 and the SW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of Sec. 15 in Tp. 27 S., R. 4 W.

I began at quarter corner between Secs. 15 and 22 T 27 S R 4 W

One of original bearing trees having been cut down I made took new witness points as follows: - Black oak 24" in dia. bears N. 44° W 22 links and a fir 12" in dia. bears S. 80° W 3 links. I then ran North (rav. 20° 40' E) intersected North line of Sec. 15 at quar. cor.

Returned to quar. corner bet. Secs 15 and 22 and ran South (rav. 20° 40' E) intersected South line of Sec. 22 24 links East of quar. cor. I took new witness points for this corner, <sup>and being nearly obliterated</sup> as follows: a fir 30" bears N. 72 1/2° W 48 lks and a fir 8" in dia. bears S. 42° E. 52 lks. Thence N. 0° 10' E on true line between the E 1/2 and W 1/2 of Sec. 22. to place of beginning.
