20.00 chs. I set cedar post from which a R fir 12" dia has S 65° E 18 lbs.

Began at 1/4 cor. bet. secs. 20 & 29 and run S 00° 50' E ~~at~~ at

20.00 I set cedar post from which a R fir stump 20" dia. has N 87 1/2° E 26

I ran a true line between these two described points for S boundary of the N 1/2 of the N.W. quarter of sec 29

T. 23 S., R 4 W

Survey made for W. Bradford

Began at the cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14 & 15 in Toms. 23 S., R 4 W.

Thence South 40.18 chs to 1/4 cor bet secs 14 & 15

I set a stone (granite) at 20.09<sup>6x9x18"</sup> from sec cor. and marked a R. fir 25" dia which has N 72° 00' E
