Survey made Aug 16 1910 to Establish a line dividing the East 1/2 from the West 1/2 of the following described lands to-wit:

The lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Sec 10, The lots 2, 3, 4, 15 and 16 of Sec 9  
The lot 3, Sec 15, The lots 1 and 2 of Sec 11 all in Tp 23, S. 27 N.  
Douglas Co Oregon

Beginning at a point (Established from the meander post on left bank of Umpqua River, on the line between Secs 9 and 10, meander post recorded as being North 25.27 ch from S.W. Cor Sec 10) 10.00 chains North and 24.85 ch. East from the S.W. Cor of Sec 10

Set a Sandstone 6x8x20 in 14 inches in the ground, from which

- marked CS  
A white oak 8 in in dia, bears N 58° W 8 links
- " " " 8 " " " 1 " S 8 1/2° E 61 "

Thence North 42.00 chains Set a Sandstone 8x12x12 inches 10 in in the ground from which

- A Red Fir 32 in in dia marked CS, bears S 65° E 12 links
- " " " 32 " " " " " " " S 75° W 58 "

The above line gives Louis Rapp, Lots 5 and 6 and that part of Lots 7 and 9 of Sec 10 lying East of the above line  
Lots 1 and 2 of Sec 11 and Lot 3 of Sec 15

And Anna J. Haynes - Lot 8 and that part of Lots 7 and 9 lying West of the above line, also Lots 2, 3, 4, 15 and 16 of Sec 9
